

Judge Williams' Rules for Docket Scheduling

Effective April 22, 2013

Ex Parte, Hearings, No-Fault, Pro Se Matters, and Conferences (Mondays only):

- Can only be set on Mondays at 9:00.
- Rule 81 Matters should only be set in the county in which they were filed. A Fiat is required if it is set out of the county in which it was filed.
- Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays are reserved for TRIALS ONLY.

Trial Dates:

- May only be set on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday at 9:00.
- There will be no more than four (4) trials set on any given day.
- An Attorney cannot have more than three (3) trials set on any given day.

Pre-Trial Conferences

- Pre-trial conferences are required at least two (2) weeks before the trial date.
- Pre-trial conferences may be set on MONDAYS or FRIDAYS ONLY.

Scheduling Orders

- Scheduling Orders are required for trials set for two (2) or more days.
- Scheduling Orders must be presented at least four (4) weeks in advance of trial.

Pre-Trial Motions

- Pre-trial Motions must be set at least one (1) week prior to trial on MONDAYS ONLY.
